Special Duty (Cheveley Park Stakes), Awzaan (Middle Park Stakes) and Twice Over (Champion Stakes) have triumphed on GB soil at Newmarket – while Gitano Hernando (Goodwood Stakes at Santa Anita), Champs Elysees (Canadian International at Woodbine), Speed Gifted (Metropolitan Handicap at Randwick), Ask (Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp), and Hearts of Fire (Gran Criterium in Milan), have flown GB flags abroad.
